DAY 1: TRANSFER IN + CITY TOUR

Cartagena de Indias

Reception, and transfer with assistance in private service, from Rafael Nuñez International Airport to the chosen hotel.

There are several options to flight from Bogota to Cartagena in the morning.

At 2:30 Departure from the hotel to the Getsemaní neighborhood for a quiet walk through its streets and squares, full of history, culture and Cartagena traditions that are reflected in its architecture, its murals and its inhabitants. We get on the bus to go to Castillo San Felipe de Barajas, the most amazing fortress built in America in order to defend the city from constant pirate attacks. Today it is recognized as one of the seven wonders of Colombia and declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. We continue with a visit to the Emerald Museum, to learn all the details of the most beautiful stone in Colombia.

Duration: approximately 3 hours

Difficulty level: Low

It includes: Transport, Specialized English speaking guide, Entrance to Castillo San Felipe de Barajas, Entrance to the Emerald Museum

Does Not include: Food or drinks, Additional services not described in the tour.

DAY 2: ROSARIO ISLANDS

Day Tour

Breakfast at the hotel

Visit the Rosario Island, departing at 9:00 from the Bodeguita Pier to the Corales del Rosario National Natural Reserve, which is an archipelago where you can enjoy crystal clear waters and small white sand beaches, located just 50 minutes by speedboat from Cartagena. In this place you can enjoy a beach time, a typical lunch and also have the possibility of contracting other activities directly, such as visiting the aquarium with a dolphin and shark show, snorkeling, among others.

Duration: approximately 7 hours

Difficulty level: Low

It includes: Transfer in fast boat, typical lunch with coconut rice, fried plantains and salad

Does Not include: Transfer hotel - pier - hotel

Recommendations: The use of sunscreen and a hat/cap is recommended, as well as comfortable clothing and shoes.

DAY 3: WALKING TOUR AND TRANSFER OUT

9:00 am The Cartagena of García Márquez Tour, (1927-2014) known as Gabo, was awarded the Nobel Prize for Literature for his work "One Hundred Years of Solitude" a matchless tribute to magical realism, his main literary style. Cartagena marked much of the literary history and life of Gabriel García Márquez. Tour through the places that evoke his presence and that of many of his characters in the charming streets of the Historic Center, where reality is confused with magic. It will be like living in the midst of magical realism.

Duration: 2 hours aprox.

Difficulty level: Low

It includes: Guide, Audioguide, map.

Does Not include: Transfer hotel - historic center - hotel

We recommend to use sunscreen and a hat/cap, as well as comfortable clothing and shoes.
