




CABO DE LA VELA

La Guajira is desert, trade winds, beach and sea

3 NIGHTS - 4 DAYS



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Traveling to La Guajira is going to one of the most distant points in Colombia, it is a place full of magic and fantasy. Its landscape is a mixture of sea, sand, salt and many cacti; It is a long journey through an ocean of orange sand as surreal as you can only find in the Colombian Caribbean.

Away from everything that modernity means in the 21st century, in La Guajira this will not be necessary when you can sleep lulled by the sound of the sea under the light of the stars.



DAY 1: RIOHACHA - CABO DE LA VELA

Deserts, trade winds, beach and sea

11:00 Reception at the Riohacha airport and transfer aboard 4x4 trucks for an hour and a half to Manaure, where you will observe the sea salt flats and salt exploitation, and possibly admire the pink tones that are produced in the water.

12:30 Arrival at the ICHI Salt Museum restaurant for lunch.

2:30 pm tour of the Salt Museum for half an hour approx.

3:00 pm They continue the journey through the desert of La Guajira until they reach Cabo de la Vela, arriving at 5:00 pm at the Lighthouse to appreciate a beautiful sunset. (Subject to Climate conditions)

6:00 pm Transfer from the Lighthouse to the Rancheria Utta to check into the hotel and have dinner

DAY 2: CABO DE LA VELA

A magical place

8:00 a.m. After breakfast in Cabo de la Vela we will arrive at Jepira, a sacred place of the Wayúu indigenous community, walk to Kaimaichi or Cerro del Pilón de Azúcar and in Punta Arcoiris you will enjoy the most exotic desert landscapes that are mixed with the immensity of the Caribbean Sea.

12:00 Lunch,

3:00 pm. After a short break we will enjoy the Ojo de Agua Beaches, where this precious liquid flows from the rocks;

17:00 We return to the Ranchería to appreciate a Cultural Show of the Wayúu Indigenous (indigenous community that lives in this region) for 2 hours.

7:00 p.m. Dinner

DAY 3: RIOHACHA

8:00 am Departure to Mayapo

14:30 Transfer to Riohacha in a tour of 50 minutes approx. and stay in a hotel



DAY 4: TRANSFER OUT

Departure from the hotel at the appropriate time to take the flight back to Bogotá

- Permanent transportation in special 4x4 trucks to cross the desert.
- Accommodation for 2 nights in Cabo de la Vela at the Ranchería Utta facing the Caribbean Sea + 1 night in Riohacha at the Taroa hotel
- Food: 3 lunches, 3 dinners and 3 breakfasts according to a pre-established menu.
- Places included: Salinas de Manaure, Cabo de la Vela, Pilón de Azúcar beach, Punta Arcoiris, El Faro, Ojo de Agua beaches, Riochacha.
- Permanent accompaniment by guide in English.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Program designed for people interested in interacting with the Wayúu indigenous culture to get to know, respect and value them, in turn appreciate this adventure-type journey that is a demanding route, without the travel comforts of conventional tourism. Electric power is obtained from gasoline generators, solar panels and wind power. The road through the desert is rough and dusty. Permanent sun and constant heat during the day and cold at night.
- It does not require physical demand, level of difficulty is low.
- The destination is not equipped for people with reduced mobility
- Wear comfortable shoes and clothing, sun protection with a hat or cap, and sunscreen.
- It is suggested to bring cash, personal hygiene items, flashlights. Prescription medications should be carried with you.
- The places to visit do not have Wi-Fi signal
