

Why did we choose this trip to Nuquí?

The Pacific is one of those hidden gems of nature tourism in Colombia, a region little explored by travelers, maybe for the conflict that existed, for state neglect or simply because it does not appear on the tourist maps, however, it surprises visitors; dozens of rivers and gorges with crystal-clear waters, one of the most biodiverse jungles in the world, kilometers of secluded beaches and communities eager to show their territory and customs.

Visit Nuquí is the perfect opportunity to discover tourism that respects its rhythm of life and the environment and will lead you to discover scenarios and sensations: the peace transmitted by the jungle and its sounds, the strength of waves, the emotion of seeing humpback whales, the freedom to explore the beaches and flavors of traditional cuisine.



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
Starting & Ending point: : Bogotá, ColombiaTravel duration: 3 days 2 nightsTravel dates: Septiembre 6 to 8

Day 1 – Arrival in Nuqui and Love waterfall: The host will wait for you at Nuqui airport to welcome you and walk you to the dock, where you will board a boat, it will be a journey of approximately 45 minutes. Upon arrival at the lodge, you can settle in the cabins, once you be ready, you will start a walk along the beach to visit La Cascada del Amor (Love Waterfall), a refreshing waterfall of fresh water that comes out of the jungle looking for the sea.

Day 2– whale watching and cooking class: After breakfast, you will embark on the journey in search of the Yubarta whales and be surprised by the magnificence of the Pacific sea. Back at the hotel, lunch.

You'll help to collect herbs and fruits to be part of a traditional cooking class where you'll learn from local cookers

Day 3 – End of the trip: according to departure time, you'll take a boat back to Nuquí where travel experience ends


