



POS-03 Soaring Over Cappadocia: Fairy Tale Spires and Underground Cities 16 – 19 NOVEMBER

Delve deeper into Cappadocia's rich cultural heritage with a pottery workshop, where you can immerse yourself in the ancient art of pottery making. For a taste of the region's flavors, indulge in a wine-tasting experience, savoring the unique wines that thrive in Cappadocia's fertile soils.



DAY 1 / 16 NOV SAT/ ARRIVAL

After you have breakfast at your convention hotel, check out at 12:00 and transfer to Istanbul Airport for your flight to Kayseri. Upon arrival, meet at the airport with SATW Conference logo sign and transfer to your hotel, check-in, and refresh. Transfer to Areni Restaurant for dinner between 19:30 – 21:00. Overnight Cappadocia Cave Hotel. (D)

DAY 2 / 17 NOV SUN / CAPPADOCIA

Your adventure starts early with an unforgettable hot air balloon ride over Cappadocia's surreal landscape, offering breathtaking views of the fairy chimneys and unique rock formations bathed in the golden light of dawn. Depending on the weather conditions your guide will inform you the pick up time from the hotel a day before. After landing, you will be transferred to the hotel for breakfast. Your guide will meet you at 09:00 at the lobby. The first destination is the Göreme Open Air Museum, 30 minutes away from your hotel, a UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its rock-cut churches, intricate frescoes, and monastic communities. Here, you will explore the Karanlık Church and the Tokalı Church, both exemplary of Eastern Roman Empire (Byzantine) art and architecture. Göreme Museum will take around 1,5 hours. Following a morning steeped in history, you will transfer to a local restaurant for lunch to savor traditional Turkish cuisine between 12:30 – 13:30. After lunch, your journey continues to Paşabağ Valley, famed for its remarkable fairy chimneys and serene landscape. Afterward, you will visit a pottery workshop, where you get a firsthand look at the ancient craft, unique to the region. Return to the hotel at 18:00 for a brief refreshment then transfer to Old Greek House restaurant for dinner between 19:30 – 21:00. Overnight Cappadocia cave Hotel. (B/L/D)



DAY 3 / 18 NOV MON/ CAPPADOCIA

Your day begins with a delightful breakfast at the hotel, gearing up for a culturally rich tour in Cappadocia. The morning continues at 09:00 with a visit to the Kaymaklı Underground City, 30 minutes drive from your hotel, one of the largest and most fascinating underground systems built by ancient communities to protect themselves from invasions. Underground city visit takes around 45 minutes. Next, you head to Mustafapaşa Village, also known as Sinasos, famous for its beautifully preserved Greek architecture and rich cultural heritage. Have lunch at a local restaurant between 12:30 – 13:30. After lunch, transfer to a local winery for vine tasting celebrating the region's ancient tradition of winemaking. Transfer back to hotel for refreshment at 18:00. In the evening, transfer to Argos Nahita restaurant for a sumptuous dinner paired with more exquisite local wines. Overnight Cappadocia cave Hotel. (B/L/D)

- All ancient cities are flat and easy to walk, tennis shoes will be perfect.
- Underground city may depress those who have claustrophobia.

DAY 4 /19 NOV TUE/ DEPARTURE

Transfer to Kayseri Airport for departure. Estimated arrival at İstanbul Airport is at 13:30.(B).
