Pay homage to the beloved saint at the Church of St. Nicholas, a place of pilgrimage and reflection. The charming town of Kaş, where crystal-clear waters and bustling markets beckon you to explore. The Lycian region is a place where history comes to life, nature enchants the senses, and every corner holds a discovery. Don't miss the opportunity to uncover the secrets of Lycia on this unforgettable journey.









DAY 1 / 9 NOV SAT/ ARRIVAL

Arrive at İstanbul Airport by 17:00 for your flight to Dalaman. Upon arrival, meet at the airport with SATW Conference logo sign and transfer 45 minutes to your hotel, check-in, and refresh. Later, enjoy dinner at Fethiye Fish Market between 19:30 – 21:00, before returning to the hotel for the night. Overnight Ece Saray Hotel. (D)

DAY 2 / 10 NOV SUN / TLOS – XANTHOS - LETOON

After breakfast checkout at 08:30 and transfer 1 hour to the ancient city of Tlos. As one of the oldest and most important Lycian cities, Tlos boasts fascinating ruins, including rock-cut tombs, a hilltop fortress, and Roman baths, offering insights into the region's rich history. After exploring Tlos, you'll head to a local restaurant for a delectable lunch between 12:00 – 13:00 savoring regional flavors.

After lunch, 1 hour drive will bring you to the ancient city of Xanthos, a UNESCO World Heritage site renowned for its impressive monuments such as the Harpy Tomb and the Nereid Monument. Drive 20 minutes to Letoon, another UNESCO site that served as a significant religious center of the Lycian civilization, containing temples dedicated to Leto, Artemis, and Apollo.

After immersing yourself in the ancient wonders, you'll transfer 1 hours to the ancient city of Patara, the birthplace of St. Nicholas and home to one of the longest beaches in Türkiye. Explore its ruins, which include a well-preserved theater and the majestic assembly hall of the Lycian League. We will see the sunset from the beach and drive 30 minutes to Islamlar Village for a local dinner at a trout farm between 19:00 – 20:30. Drive 1 hour to your hotel in Kaş for check-in and refreshments. Overnight Kaş Radisson Blu Hotel. (B/L/D)

All ancient cities are flat and easy to walk, tennis shoes will be perfect.





DAY 3 / 11 NOV MON/ KAŞ - MYRA

Have breakfast at the hotel and check-out at 08:30.

Wake up in the charming coastal town of Kaş, where you can enjoy a leisurely walk and some free time to explore its vibrant markets and picturesque harbor. At 10:00 your journey continues to the ancient city of Myra which is 1 hour drive. Lunch at a local restaurant between 12:30 – 13:30. Myra is famous for its rock-cut tombs and the impressive Roman theater. While in Myra, you'll also visit St. Nicholas Church, a historically significant site dedicated to the saint who inspired the modern-day Santa Claus.

Following these enriching visits, you'll transfer 2 hours to your hotel in Antalya. After checking in and refreshing, you'll be transported to 7 Mehmet restaurant for a delightful dinner, rounding off a day filled with historical exploration and cultural delights. Overnight Rixos Hotel. (B/L/D)

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DAY 4/12 NOV TUE/ DEPARTURE

Transfer to Antalya Airport for departure. Estimated arrival at İstanbul Airport is at 13:30. From there, transfer directly to your convention hotel for check-in. (B)
