 later echoed here in the worship of Mary





GÖREME OPEN AIR MUSEUM

- One of the first two UNESCO sites in Türkiye
- Christian monasteries that date back to the
 8th 11th century
- where the ideas of Christianity were unified by Cappadocian Fathers who laid the foundation for the theology of the Christian doctrine of the Holy Trinity,
- a huge monastic complex composed of scores of refectory monasteries placed side-by-side, each with its own church
- the rock-cut churches often feature beautiful frescoes

- Hiking/Trekking: Cappadocia is also a veritable paradise for nature hikers. Hiking around Cappadocia is a unique experience offering some of the most surreal scenery in the world.

NEOLITHIC SITE OF ÇATALHÖYÜK, KONYA

UNESCO World Heritage Site 2012

- Çatalhöyük is the first urban city settlement in the world
- The archaeological evidence shows a complicated social organization
 - The elegantly decorated houses and the elaborate artifacts that were found here indicate a sophisticated society that goes beyond what could be associated with a village



NEOLITHIC SITE OF ÇATALHÖYÜK, KONYA

- Çatalhöyük is the first urban city settlement in the world
- The earliest shrine of the Earth Mother is at Çatalhöyük
- Hundreds of statues of the Anatolian Mother Goddess unearthed at Çatalhöyük and they can be seen at the Museum of Anatolian Civilizations in Ankara.









HATTUSA: The Hittite Capital

- The capital of the Hittite Empire 2000 BCE
- Ancient temples and palaces, monumental sculptures, and the enormous fortification walls with ceremonial gates and tunnels
- Many cuneiform clay tablets that shed light to history (Kadesh Peace Treaty)
- The Open Air Rock Sanctuary of Yazılıkaya
