DAY 1 / 9 NOV SAT/ ARRIVAL

Arrive at İstanbul Airport for your flight to Trabzon with TK2832 16:15 – 18:05. Upon arrival, meet at the airport with SATW Conference logo sign and transfer to your hotel, check-in, and refresh. Transfer to a local restaurant for dinner at Tirvana between 19:00 -20:30. Overnight Ramada Plaza.(D)

DAY 2 / 10 NOV SUN / TRABZON

After breakfast, meet with your guide at 09:00 and transfer to the iconic Hagia Sophia Mosque, a magnificent structure with a rich history that spans both Byzantine and Ottoman periods. Later drive to the Atatürk Pavilion, a charming early 20th-century mansion that offers insights into the life of Türkiye's founding father, Mustafa Kemal Atatürk, and provides spectacular views of the city from its hilltop position. After immersing yourself in history, you'll head to a local restaurant for a delightful lunch featuring authentic Turkish cuisine. Next, a 45 minutes drive will take us to the Sümela Monastery awaits a stunning Greek Orthodox monastery built into the cliffs of the Altındere National Park. This remarkable site offers not only spiritual enrichment but also breathtaking natural views. Following the monastery visit, drive back to the hotel at 17:30 for refreshments then drive to dinner at Müzeyyen restaurant between 19:00 – 20:30. Overnight Ramada Plaza. (B/L/D)

DAY 3 / 11 NOV MON/ RİZE

After breakfast and check-out from your hotel at 09:00, you'll be transferred to the renowned Sürmene Knife Factory for about 45 minutes along the coastal road. Here, you'll witness the traditional craftsmanship of Sürmene knives, famed for their exceptional quality and intricate designs. This visit will give you a glimpse into the rich cultural heritage of Turkish artisans. Next, you'll head to Çayeli for a delightful lunch at a local restaurant, where you can savor regional specialties that highlight the flavors of this part of Türkiye. After lunch, your journey continues to Çeçeva, a picturesque village famous for its lush tea plantations and scenic landscapes. Here, you'll get an insight into the tea cultivation process and perhaps enjoy a refreshing cup of Turkish tea.

Finally, you'll be transferred to your hotel in Rize for check-in dinner at the hotel. Dinner at Oz Balık between 19:00 – 20:30 and overnight Ramada Plaza Rize Hotel. (B/L/D)
